Diep Thanh Vang is 12 years old. He and his mother were abandoned by his father 3 years ago. They now live in a rented 12 x 12 foot room with Vang's aunt. His mother works in the kitchen of a restaurant. She works long hours and sometimes sleeps there too. When she misses Vang too much, she comes to school to see him.

This summer Vang worked every day at Anh Linh school to earn a little money to help his mother and aunt pay the rent. Cam Thuy, the principal, reports that he is a very good worker. "I've given him a key

to the school," Thuy said. "He comes on time every morning to open the school for himself and a couple of other kids who are also working at the school this summer. He wants very badly to stay in school, but he needs help. He wants to be an engineer when he grows up, but first he wants to buy a ring for his mom."

Vang's story is similar to so many of the children at Anh Linh. They are good kids, smart kids, responsible kids, but they need the break Bridges to Learning and you can give them to end the cycle of poverty in their lives.

## Primary School Reconstruction

In 2007 the new middle school was completed, thanks in large part to your contributions. The project was so successful that funds remained to enable Anh Linh to take another important step and rebuild the primary school.

Anh Linh began 17 years ago in a vacant pig sty and the next primary school was little more than a hodgepodge of small spaces cobbled together to serve as classrooms. No one would have imagined the wonderful facilities that will soon be available for study and learning. Bridges to Learning shared the dream of the Sisters of Notre Dame and generous people like you helped realize that dream.

Last fall, all the children took classes in the new school with primary students attending morning and the secondary students attending afternoon sessions.

The demolition of old structures on the primary lot began in March, and the new school is

emerging from the rubble and will be ready for occupancy this fall.

Anh Linh has added grade 8 to the school curriculum this fall, bringing the total number of students to 265. Only one new grade is permitted each year, therefore the school will not reach its full potential until the fall of 2009.

## Sisters of St. Joseph Awards \$7,500 Grant





Peter Sammond, Bridges to Learning board chair, has announced a grant of \$7,500 from the Sisters of
