## Who we help

Poor children in Vietnam have limited opportunities for education and few options to break the cycle of poverty.

Primary education in Vietnam is not free, and the costs associated with education – notebooks, uniforms ... even pens and pencils – are outside the reach of many children and their families.

Bridges to Learning's support for the Anh Linh and Viet Anh Schools allows any child who is too poor, or too old to attend school for free. Some without families or home are provided housing in the schools' dormitories at no cost.
