
School year closing ceremony 2022 – 2023

This year, there are a total of 149 students enrolled in the school, with 90 of them belonging to ethnic group minorities such as Châu Ma and others. In order for the school activities to run smoothly, a team of 8 Soeurs are working alongside 13 teachers and 3 staff members in our community.

Visiting students' homes

As a part of our annual school tradition at the start of every new school year, we intend to visit the homes of our students. This is of the utmost importance for us as it allows us to gain insights into the students' behaviors, their living environment, and their overall growth. By doing so, we can sympathize with their behaviors and approach them with the most effective and appreciative methods for each student.

After studying at school, the students return to their villages. The Viet Anh students hail from different parts of Lam Dong Province, including places like Đồng Nai Thượng - Cát Tiên (60km away from the school, with 20km of mountain pass), Madaguoi – Đạ Huoai (25km away), Đạ Nhar (12km away), Tố Lan (10km away), Tôn K' Long (45km away), and Lộc Bắc (25km away). Most of these students come from families who earn their livelihood through farming and breeding, so they have a difficult life.



We are immensely grateful for the charitable helpers who have supported us at Viet Anh School in Đạ Tẻh, in our mission to provide education to children with love. We hope that the collective efforts of all our helpers will empower the children in this community to achieve holistic development and cultivate a sense of hope for a better and brighter future.
